Social distancing information

In order to ensure the safety of our patients, staff and visitors, we are practicing social distancing within our Treatment Centre. You will see when you attend we have implemented rules and practices to enable the protection of us all. We would kindly ask that you comply where possible.

Rules and Practices:

- When your appointment is confirmed, you will be asked that when you arrive at the Centre, you enter the free car park and remain in your car then telephone **01246 575098** to let us know you have arrived. A staff member will then contact you to let you know when it is your turn to be seen.
- If you are being escorted to the Centre, your escort must stay with your car until you are ready to leave, as you may be asked to return to your car during your appointment to help us manage patient numbers in the clinic.
- On arrival into the Centre, your temperature will be taken. You will also be asked questions relating to your current health condition.
- You will notice floor markers indicating the two metre distance we are required to keep to be safe.
- You will be asked to wear a mask, if you have your own mask, please feel free to wear it otherwise one will be provided for you.
- Unfortunately due to the COVID precautions, there are no refreshment facilities available. We would advise that you bring a drink with you e.g. a bottle of water.

Please note: If you are coming to the Centre for surgery, unfortunately we are unable to permit visitors at this time due to the COVID 19 precautions.

Covid notice

We kindly ask that if you have any symptoms of COVID 19 such as a new cough, loss of taste or smell or a high temperature, you do NOT attend the Centre and remain at home until your symptoms have passed.

If you have a member of your household with symptoms, again we ask that you do NOT attend the Centre.
